INTRODUCTION

Our founder had always dreamed of empowering women through education. This dream came true in an emphatic fashion recently when Smt.Nirmala Seetharaman, an Economics alumna of Seethalakshmi Ramaswami College, became the Minister of Finance and Corporate Affairs.

Seethalakshmi Ramaswami College (SRC) has helped educate and empower generations of women who are now successfully dispersed throughout the world. At a time when education of women was frowned upon, our founder had the courage and conviction to provide school and college education to girls in the backdrop of Indian values and culture. To this day, our college rigorously follows the founding ideals by providing affordable education to girls from disadvantaged appropriate and appears and appears to the selection of the selection



from disadvantaged economic and social backgrounds. Since the founder's passing in 1976, the college has been managed and enhanced by his son **Sri.R.Panchapakesan**, who serves as the Secretary and the Managing Trustee. He is ably assisted by his son **Dr.Kannan Panchapakesan**, a Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering from the University of Arizona, USA.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

Seethalakshmi Ramaswami College Offers 21 U.G. programmes, 15 P.G. programmes, 7 M.Phil. programmes, and 8 Ph.D. programmes. With 4500 students and 200 faculty, SRC is a force to be reckoned with in women's education today. SRC was one of the first colleges in the Tiruchirappalli area to opt for autonomous status in the year 1987. This has allowed us to experiment and innovate in curricular aspects. The college has come to be recognized as a pioneer in designing and offering new courses. For example, Bio-technology, Electronics, Hospital Administration, Commerce Applied, Nutrition & Dietetics were some of the innovative courses that drew the attention of peer institutions and prospective students at the time of their introduction. With the introduction of **Choice Based Credit System(CBCS)** many useful courses like 'An Introduction to Archaeology' by the Department of History, Fashion Accessories' by the Department of Home Science, 'Dietary Guidance and Counseling' by the Department of Nutrition & Dietetics, 'Stem Cell Biology' by the Department of Bio-technology, and 'Entrepreneurial Electronics' by the Department of Electronics were introduced. Another first to its credit is that SRC happened to be one of the first 7 colleges in the country to be accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 1999. In the most recent assessment by NAAC, the college was accredited with an "A+" grade in recognition of its all-round academic excellence, research programs, and social outreach activities.

INFRASTRUCTURE

In order to provide a nurturing learning environment, it is essential to make sure the infrastructure of the college keeps pace with the latest developments in the various relevant areas. Some of the highlights from recent years include:

- ◆ Saraswathi Block: Constructed at a cost of Rs. 4 crores, this 3-storey edifice houses a spacious, modern, and fully-automated library, a commodious reading room area, 2 seminar halls, a PC-based English language laboratory and an internet-enabled computer center with 258 Computers.
- ◆ Manickavinayagar Hall: A massive outdoor auditorium that can accommodate the entire student population of the college has been constructed at a cost of Rs. 40 lakhs.
- ◆ Athletics Track : A 6-lane athletics track with an expansive sports area in the middle has been developed to cater to track and field events at a cost of Rs. 35 lakhs.
- ◆ **Road Network**: At a cost of Rs. 60 lakhs, majority of the roads inside the campus have been upgraded from being tar-topped to being laid with high-quality cement paver blocks to allow for easier maintenance and handling.
- ◆ Water and Sanitation: Many of the water-holding structures and their associated plumbing infrastructure have been upgraded for enhanced water safety and security. Several water purifiers have been installed around the campus to provide safe drinking water. New toilets have been constructed and older toilets rebuilt to promote proper health and hygiene of the students.
- ◆ **Solar Power**: In the last couple of years, solar panels with a capacity of 35 KW at a cost of Rs. 25 lakhs have been installed with the goal of reducing power expenses and as well as contributing to the renewable energy mission promoted by the Government of India.
- ◆ **E-Studio**: E-Studio has the state-of-the art infrastructure. Faculty members develop e-teaching and learning materials using EyeRIS software, through which students gain knowledge in upcoming and current fields of study.
- ◆ Multimedia Hall: The lectures and programmes designed under the Swayam Prabha scheme of MHRD are telecast in the Multimedia Hall to ensure that the students are sensitized to the recent developments in their field of study.
- ◆ **Smart Classroom**: Smart classrooms provide opportunities for teaching and learning by combining learning technologies, audio-visual tools and internet facility.

PLACEMENT

Our college realizes that one of the top goals of education is to make the students employable and ensure that they succeed in the real world after graduation. Towards this end, the college through its Placement Cell, diligently prepares its students by improving communication and English fluency, imparting essential computer skills, conducting mock interviews and careful career counseling. Apart from this, students are provided career opportunities through arranging interviews with institutions and companies such as SRV School-Trichy, MAM School - Salem Sri Saradha Memorial High School-Salem, Kongu Nadu School - Nammakkal, Wipro, CTS and Capgemini Technology Services.
