- Poster should contain personal details like Name, Class and College of the participants.
- Participant should submit an audio clip explaining the topic and content of the poster. The audio clip should not be more than 3 minutes of duration. Student can explain their posters in English.
- Winning poster will receive cash prize and appreciation certificate and E certificates for all the participants.
- Decision taken by organizing team will be the final.
- Judgment will be based on the relevance to the theme, originality, artistic composition creativity and effectiveness in communicating the intended message.
