



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Our Institution.

Seethalakshmi Ramaswami College is a renowned women's institution. It is an autonomous institution affiliated to Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli, Tamil Nadu. At the time when women's education was not much favored in the society, our founder Padmabushan Shri. N.Ramaswami Ayyar founded the institution with the noble purpose of educating them. His ardent desire was to provide modern education to women in the background of the rich Indian culture. Autonomy was conferred in 1988 and the college utilizes autonomy especially in the fields of Curricular Aspects, Teaching, Learning and Evaluation to impart quality education. The institution celebrated its Diamond Jubilee (1951–2011) and is marching ahead successfully. Every year more than 4000 graduates leave this portal of learning with adequate orientation in Indian tradition and culture. The College offers 24 UG and 17 PG programmes. 8 departments are with Research status. Abreast with the sacred mission of our Honorable Prime Minister, in promoting an economically self-supporting and entrepreneurial society through National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF), our college was selected by UGC to offer a programme on Sericulture under Community College Scheme and 5 B.Voc. programmes namely Electronic Circuit Designing & Electrician, Fashion Technology & Apparel Designing, Food Processing, Horticultural Science and Yoga alternate therapy for the remote, rural women folk of Tiruchirappalli. It is also one of the first 7 colleges in the country to be accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 1999. In the recent fourth cycle assessment by NAAC, the college was accredited with the prestigious A + grade in recognition of its all around academic excellence, research performance and social outreach activities.

Our Department

The department of Nutrition and Dietetics was incepted in the year 1983. The undergraduate programme in Nutrition and Dietetics includes the complete study of basic components of foods; their nutrients, chemistry and metabolism; technology involved in food processing and preservation; food safety; functional food and nutrigenomics; meal planning, quantity food production and therapeutic dietary modifications with a focus on human health and well-being. Nutrition is the foundation for good health that is a vital component of national development. The department is making concerted efforts to achieve the national goal of "Health for All" through its continuous societal outreach activities in the rural areas serving the women and children, there by realizing the vision of our esteemed institution. Since its inception, the department has directed its activities towards development of the community to shape the prospective academicians, administrators, researchers, entrepreneurs and health conscious citizens. B.Voc. Food Processing was awarded in 2018 by the University Grants Commission under the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) which is a flagship programme of the Skill India Initiative. It is a three years Undergraduate Programme that aims at imparting practical and industry relevant skill in the domains of food processing and food technology produce employable work force.
