# **ESSAY WRITING**

- 1. Maximum word limit 1000 words.
- 2. The language should be in Tamil, English, Hindi & Sanskrit on the theme

- 3. The essay should be typed in times new roman, 12 size with double spacing.
- 4. The hand written essays will be accepted only for offline participants.
- 5. The essay should be the original work of the student and it should not be copied from anywhere. The writing should not have grammatical error as well as overlapping of contents.
- 6. The introduction and conclusion of the essay should be proper and rational.
- 7. The evaluation will be made on the basis of content, coverage, facts, writing spirit inclined towards the topic and logical presentation with due rationale. The decision of the Jury shall be final & binding on all the participants.
- 8. The printout of the Essay as per above specification should be taken and signed on all pages by the participating student. Further, the cleared scanned copy of the same should be sent at the designated email id as per the directions of the organizers.
