About the College

The college which had a humble beginning in 1951 now offers 24 Undergraduate programmes, 15 Postgraduate programmes, 7 M.Phil. programmes, 8 Ph.D. programmes, 1 Community College course (Sericulture), and 5 B.Voc. programmes. B.A. Music was started in the year 1966 under the aided section. Since its inception, the students have secured I rank consecutively. Being the favourite subject of our founder, M.A. Music was also started in 1987 under self - financed section. 
