Write लिख	लिख+आ = लिखा	लिख+ए = लिखे	लिख+ई =लिखी	लिख+ईं = लिखीं
Speak बोल	बोल+ आ = बोला	बोल+ए = बोले Procentor:	बोल+ई = बोली	बोल+ई = बोलीं

ने (Na) Rule in Hindi

- 🕨 ने is used in Past Tense with Transitive Verb.
- ➤ When ¬is used verb agrees with the Number & Gender of the Object not subject.
- When the Object is understood then the verb always remains in Masculine Singular form.
- ➤ When the object is followed by a case ending then the verb remains in Masculine Singular form.
- 🕨 ने is not used with some compound verb like ला, बोल, भूल, सक, चुक, मिल, पहुँच |
